

## **Sarah Smith Primary Campus Carpool and Safety Rules**

- **NO LEFT TURN** into or out of the parking lot from Old Ivy Road between 7:30 a.m. and 8 a.m. and again between 2:15 p.m. and 3 p.m.
- While waiting on Old Ivy Road to turn right into the school's driveway, pull as far right as possible to allow through traffic to pass.
- **DROP OFF AND PICK UP IN THE MAIN CARPOOL CIRCLE ONLY** – not on Land O' Lakes, in the bus lane, in the carpool line prior to entering the carpool circle, or in the parking lot behind the cafeteria.
- When in the carpool circle, follow direction of school staff.
- Do not use your cell phone or other electronic devices while in the carpool line. Distracted drivers keep the carpool lines from moving efficiently and are a safety hazard to the students.
- Pull as far forward as possible when dropping off and picking up. **Do not stop in front of the school doors unless it is the furthest forward point.**
- Carpool numbers must be displayed during afternoon pickup. **Display your carpool number by hanging the provided tag from the rearview mirror with the number facing outward.** If you're carpool number is not available, please use a black marker to write your number on a paper plate or 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper. Make sure the number is large and legible.
- If parking at the school near or during arrival or dismissal hours, **do not part in the bus lane, carpool circle, or along the entrance or exit lanes to the school – including the sidewalk in front of the media center.**
- Do not park in the **No Parking Zone on the top left corner of Land O' Lakes where it meets Old Ivy.** This is a parking hazard and impedes the flow of traffic.
- When parking on **Old Ivy, only park on the side of the street adjacent to the school lot.** This will allow traffic to flow smoothly.
- Be respectful of the school's neighbors and their property. Do not block driveways.
